

Programming a GatewayPro with the User Configuration Tool (UCT)

THE USER CONFIGURATION TOOL (UCT)

The User Configuration Tool (UCT) is an easy way to link I/O points in your wireless network, view I/O register values graphically, and set system communication parameters when a host system is not part of the wireless network.

Typically, the UCT works with a standard SureCross® DX80 or Performance Gateway, but the UCT can be used with the GatewayPro when you follow these steps:

- Remove all four jumpers that are normally used to select between RS-485 and RS-232 (shown).
 Note how the jumpers are installed because you need to return the jumpers
 - because you need to return the jumpers back into this position when you are finished.
- 2. Plug the UCT cable into the GatewayPro.
- 3. Launch the UCT. Follow the UCT instructions and program the GatewayPro just as you would program a Gateway.
- 4. When finished with the UCT, unplug the UCT cable.
- 5. Plug the four jumpers back into the same position you removed them from.
