RE: EPA TSCA 6(h) Rules for Five Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT) Chemicals

To Whom It May Concern:

In December 2020, EPA issued five final rules to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT), effective February 5, 2021.

These rules limit or prohibit the manufacture (including import), processing, and/or distribution in commerce (including within articles) the following PBT chemicals:

DecaDBE	A flame retardant used in plastic enclosures and in wire and cables for electronic equipment
PIP (3:1)	A plasticizer, a flame retardant, an anti-wear additive or an anti-compressibility additive in hydraulic fluid, lubricants and greases, industrial coatings, adhesives, sealants and plastic articles
2,4,6-TTBP	A reactant incorporated into fuel and fuel-related additives
HCBD	A chemical produced as a by-product during the manufacture of chlorinated hydrocarbons
РСТР	A chemical used to make rubber more pliable
